



## **10 simple Civic Engagement things that EVERY non-profit can do...that builds your organization!**

**Appoint/VOTE/Choose someone at your organization to be the "civic engagement cheerleader"**

**Call your SOS and get multilingual copies of Voter Registration Cards, make sure ALL staff have at least 10-20 on them at all times, and they are at your front desk**

**Create a cool drop-box to have at your front desk**

**Encourage all your staff and board to vote.**

**-Make sure all staff, board, volunteers, interns, etc. are REGISTERED!!**

**Create a quarter page flyer with information on:**

- 1 reason why someone should vote**
- How to get a registration card at your office**
- Important election dates (i.e. last day to register, what to bring to polls,)**
- Contact person at org. who is the "civic engagement guru"**

**Include an article in your newsletter about the importance of voting, and its relationship to a particular area of interest to your organization**

**Put a message on your website**

- encouraging people to vote**
- offering voter registration cards/assistance**
- link to online Voter Registration tool**

**Create a "voter list" out of your current database**

- Add new voter registrants to your list:**
- Get permission to contact registrants**
- Add registrants to your GOTV list**

**Conduct a Voter Registration Drive at your office**
